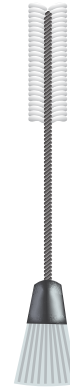


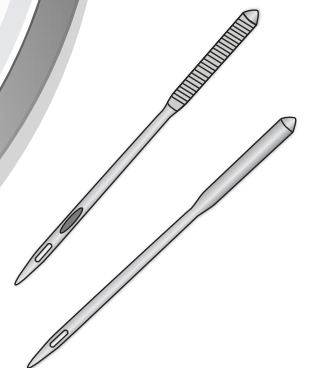
Machine Maintenance Clock

Brush lint and thread bits out of the bobbin case area after every project or even more often if you're working with flannel, wool or any fabric that throws a lot of fuzz.



Take your machine in for a full service tune up once a year. The machine doctor will do a thorough check behind the covers to keep your machine humming along.

Change the needle after every full project (piecing, quilting and binding) or after a couple piecing projects. You will hear a little thud sound with each stitch if the needle is getting dull.



Some machines need oil! Oil your machine, wherever metal meets metal in the bobbin case area, after removing the cover plate. With heavy use, you will want to oil it once a week; with moderate to light use it can be done once a month or whenever you pull it out of the closet.
