

Here's how you figure how much yardage you can get by with

Take the width and length of the backing you will need. In my case that was 55" x 55".

Width of backing minus width of fabric = 55'' - 44'' = 11''

2 x the width of fabric (44") = 88" (this is the same for all equations no matter the size of the quilt) 88" minus width needed (55") = 33"

Width needed x the difference between the width needed and the width of fabric (in this case that is $55'' \times 11''$) = 605 divided by 33 = 18.33 (for our sanity we are going to round up to 19'')

Now add 19" to 55" and that's how much yardage you can eek by with! 74" to be exact.
